## MAKERERE UNIVERSITY TO HOST THE FIRST UGANDA ENTREPRENEURSHIP CONGRESS AND 7<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP STUDENTS' EXPO 2023

The Department of Marketing and Management at Makerere University is mandated to teach Entrepreneurship in the two School of Business, College of Business and Management Sciences (CoBAMS). The Course is taught in Semester One of each Academic year to both Undergraduate and Graduate students who pursue the following Programmes:

- 1. Bachelor of Commerce (B.COM) Year One
- 2. Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) Year Two
- 3. Master of Business Administration (MBA) Year One
- 4. Master of Arts in Economic Policy Management (EPM) Year One

Since 2016, as part of the Course requirements, the Department of Marketing and Management has been organizing Annual Entrepreneurship Students' Expo through Makerere University Entrepreneurship and Outreach Centre. This year, the Centre will host the Uganda Entrepreneurship Congress and Exhibition. The congress will take place on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2023 in the Yusuf Lule Auditorium as a precursor for Exhibition which will take place on 17<sup>th</sup> November 2023 at the Makerere University Freedom Square.

The Uganda Entrepreneurship Congress is proposed to be an annual event to prepare younger entrepreneurs for the ever-evolving business landscape by focusing on innovation, sustainability and adaptability. Anite Evelyn, Minister of State for Privatization and Investment.

During the Congress (Day 1), the experts will share their insights and experiences about the changing landscape of entrepreneurship such as Rapid Advancements in Generative Technology, changing consumer preferences, market trends and sustainability among others. Additionally, there will be interactive panel discussions and individual consultations where attendees can engage with industry experts and learn practical skills to enhance their entrepreneurial ventures.

During the Exhibition, students and the community will showcase their prototypes and startups. There will also be more practical engagements with entrepreneurs, who will share how to start and sustain certain businesses. They will provide step-by-step guidance on identifying market opportunities, securing funding and developing effective marketing strategies. Participants will also have the opportunity to network with likeminded individuals and potential investors, fostering valuable connections for future collaborations.
