My safety and your safety is our collective responsibility

Forms of Abuse	Examples Of Abusive or Harmful Behavior to Report
Physical Abuse	 Smacking, Caning, Hitting, Slapping, Corporal punishment, Shaking someone aggressively Burning, Poisoning, Drowning, Suffocating
Sexual Abuse	 Rape or Sexual Assault Being forced to make sexually explicit pictures or videos Sharing sexually explicit videos of children, students or staff. Made to do something sexual to someone that is uncomfortable or wrong or watch someone do something sexual
Emotional/ Psychological Abuse (Harassment)	 Unwanted physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct that has the purpose or effect of violating a person's dignity (Verbal abuse) Creating an intimidating, hostile, degrading, humiliating or offensive environment. Isolation or non-cooperation at work, exclusion from social activities Intrusive behaviours such as pestering, spying, stalking Restriction of movement Belittling; Denigrating, Threatening, Scaring
Sexual Harassment	 Verbal and written harassment through sexually offensive jokes, language, gossip and slander Visual displays of posters, graffiti, obscene gestures Coercion for sexual favours Treating someone less favourably because they have submitted or refused to submit to sexual behaviour
Sexual Exploitation	 Exchange of money, employment, goods, or services for sex or sexual favours Grooming to sexually manipulate, exploit, or abuse Trafficking someone online or in person for sexual engagements Using or paying a sex worker; watching or sharing pornography
Financial or Commercial Exploitation	Child labour Exploitation of workers or students Stealing from another person or cheating them
Neglect or Negligent Treatment	Deliberately not providing care or attention
Discrimination	Unjust treatment based on a person's ethnicity/nationality, faith affiliation, age, sex, form/nature of disability
Bullying Including Cyberbullying	 Can take the form of physical, verbal and non-verbal conduct - online and in-person Overbearing and intimidating levels of supervision Inappropriate derogatory remarks about someone's performance Misuse of social media and digital communication channels to harass, intimidate, or threaten a person Posting hurtful or threatening messages on social media and sending inappropriate texts or emails
